Terms and Conditions

There is a minimum of 8 years of age for experiences that take place in the animals enclosure. A parent or guardian must accompany an individual under 16 years of age and will be allowed into the experience free of charge.

Please wear appropriate clothing and footwear –trousers, jeans, shoes, trainers or boots. No open toed sandals

Please advise us of any disabilities in advance, to enable us to try and adapt our encounters to suit your needs. We will do everything possible to try to accommodate everyone but sometimes this may not be possible.

It is your responsibility to advise us of any allergies* or medical condition that you or your doctor feel we should be aware of in order to ensure your safety. **We advise anybody who is or may be pregnant not to take part in any of our animal encounters.** Would all participants make sure that they are covered with an up-to-date tetanus vaccination.

Curraghs Wildlife Park accepts no liability for any person or body for any loss, injury or property damage from any action or cause whatsoever undertaken at the Park. Participants must abide by staff instructions at all times. Please be advised that animals may scratch or bite.

Due to unforeseen animal health or staffing issues, Curraghs Wildlife Park cannot guarantee that all animals and exhibits will be available. In these circumstances another date and time will be arranged or if this is not possible, a full refund will be given.

Hands should be washed thoroughly after contact with the animals.
